



How to get Emergency Prescriptions

Have you ever run out of a prescription over the weekend or a holiday period? It's easier to get an emergency prescription than you think!

You can phone 111 and explain your situation. They will send an alert to an open Pharmacy near you and then you can visit and explain what medicine you require (best take a repeat prescription form with you so pharmacist knows exactly what you need).

Alternatively, you can go online to 111 (111.nhs.uk) and put in your location postcode and what pharmacy you would like the alert to be sent to – it takes less than a couple of minutes to do this. Note....it's a good idea to call the out of hours pharmacy first to make sure they have the item you are looking for in stock.

Changes to Landline Telephones

The UK's telephone network is being upgraded, which means that landline services are changing. You can still have a landline in your home, but the technology that powers it will be different. For most, switching over will be straightforward, but some people may need new equipment or support to make the changes.

The change means the landline will use the internet to make calls, rather than old copper network (known as PSTN, or public switched telephone network). For those without a broadband connection at home, your supplier will install one.

Both BT and Virgin have committed to not charging customers any extra for landlineonly broadband connections.
